Hanson S. Conant to Gardner Conant

This Indenture made this fifth day of July in the year
One thousand eight hundred and twenty eight, witness-
eth that Hanson S. Conant, son of Gardner Conant,
aged five years eleven months and twenty nine days
by and with the consent of his father of Welshfield township.
in the County of Grauga and State of Chi; hath of his own
free will and accord placed and bound himself apprentice
unto Gardner Conant Junr. of Welshfield in the County
and State aforesaid for to learn the occupation of ag-
riculture which he the said Gardner Conant Junr now
uses, and with him as an apprentice to continue and serve
from the day of the date hereof, until he attain the age of
twenty one years, during all of which time said apprentice
his said master, shall faithfully serve his secrets keep
his lawful commands do and obey, hurt to his said mas-
ter he shall not do, nor suffer it to be done by others, but of
the same to the utmost of his power, shall forthwith give no-
tice to his said master. The Goods of his said master he
shall not embezzle, or waste, or lend them to any without his
consent, at cards or any other unlawful game, he shall not play
Taverns he shall not frequent, matrimony he shall not fre-
quent contract. From the service of his said master he shall
not at any time depart, without his leave; but in all things
as a good and faithful apprentice shall demean himself
towards his said master and all his during said term.—
And the said master in consideration of the services afore-
said, will instruct, or cause to be instructed his said ap-
prentice in the occupation of agriculture, which the said
master now useth, with all things therunto belonging, after
the best manner he can, and will also find, and allow to his
said apprentice, meat, drink, washing, lodging and apparel
(both linen and woollen) and all other necessaries both in
winter & summer convenient to said apprentice.

during the term aforesaid; and shall also well and suffi-
ciently instruct, or cause to be instructed the said appren-
tice in reading writing and arithmetic. And the said
master at the end of the term aforesaid, shall find and
allow to the said apprentice one good suit of clothes for
every day's wear, and one good suit of holly day clothes be-
fitting his condition, and shall also furnish him with a
new Bible; also one pair of three year old steers, and one three
year old heifer. - In witness whereof the parties to these
presents, have hereunto interchangably, set their hands and
seals the day and year first above written.
