

This Indenture made this day of
A. D. 1852 by and between Charles A Sanger and
Amasa Sanger father of said Charles A. of Hamden
in the County of Seangu and State of Ohio of the
one part and William Radcliff of the same place
of the other part Witnesseth that the said Amasa
Sanger hath put and placed and by these presents doth
put and bind out his said Son the said Charles A. San-
ger who was 15 years old on the day of April last
as an apprentice to the said William Radcliff to learn
the trade of a Stone Mason and by and with the con-
sent of his said Son signified by his joining in the
execution hereof with the said Radcliff to dwell as an
apprentice and him to serve as such apprentice ~~for the~~
until he the said Charles A. Sanger shall arrive at
the age of twenty one years. During all which time
the said apprentice shall faithfully serve the said
Radcliff as an apprentice, his secrets keep, obey all his
lawful Commands. Do no damage to his said master
nor willingly suffer any to be done by others, but if
any intended come to his knowledge he shall give
said Radcliff notice, he shall not waste the goods of
said Radcliff nor lend them unlawfully, At Cards or
Dice or any other unlawful game he shall not play
Taverns he shall not frequent, matrimony he shall
not contract during said term; from the service of his
said Master he shall not depart but in all things he
shall as a good & faithful apprentice demean himself
during said term of his minority. And the said
Radcliff on his part covenants and agrees to teach or
cause to be taught in the said trade of Stone Mason
and all things thereunto appertaining the said appre-
ntice in the best way or manner he can & according
to the best of his Skill, and to furnish and allow
to him and find and provide for said apprentice dur-
